### Document Proofing

Checking a document, its fonts, and its linked files to ensure that it can be effectively and efficiently output to a printer device.

- No software will eliminate proofing.
- If a print job contains photos at the wrong resolution or in the wrong color space, the document will not print right.
- If fonts are not embedded in the print job file, they must be available on the printer's computer
- If the printer margins are not known when printing the document, the document will not print correctly.

DTLink Inc. NetSpooler printing system will provide convenient and reliable document proofing prior to final output. Any print job sent to the NetSpooler printer can be easily previewed at a WYSIWYG format, as it will be printed to the target printer. It does not matter which application generated the print job. The document proofing is based on the final output devices' PPDs and are true representations of the final output in all aspects regarding completeness and accuracy of page elements, correct colors, typography, and font usage.

The print job previews are color-matched according to the target printer resolution in order to produce the final colors on a monitor for soft-proof. The size of the previews depends upon page format and target printer resolution. The compressed format of the print job will allow fast job proofing on any PC, but also convenient efficient transmission over any Internet/Intranet connection.
